


Spring Term 2023 Year 3 and 4 Scrumdiddlyumptious Homework Grid

Expressive Arts	<p>Collect pictures of a wide range of foods from magazines, newspapers, packaging etc. Think of a way to group your foods (e.g. carbohydrates, fats and sugar, dairy, fruit and veg) and make a poster showing your groups. Label them to help others understand your idea.</p>	<p>Make a bird feeder. You need an apple, sunflower seeds and string. Cut the apple in half and remove the core. Tie the string round the middle. Stick the sunflower seeds into the apple. Hang it, and then record the changes you notice in the apple or animals you see over the next few days.</p> 	<p>Paint a still life.</p> 	<p>Create a food sculpture.</p> 

Working Together	<p>Go onto the Hwb, search food chains in the search bar. Explore the food chain activity pictured below.</p> 	<p>Let's get cooking! Cook or bake a dish at home with your family. Write out the list of ingredients needed and the instructions to create your meal. Bring in a picture if you can so we can see what you made!</p>	<p>Be brave and try a new food! It could be a new fruit or vegetable or a food from another country like Indian, Chinese or Mexican food. You might discover a new favourite!</p> 	<p>Grow something at home in a pot inside or in your garden. It can be a herb or vegetable. Remember to take good care of it and once it's grown, bring it in for the class to see.</p>
Numeracy & Mathematics	<p>Keep the packaging of all the food you eat and drinks you have over a day. Once you've collected it all, calculate the total calories, sugar, and fat. Show your working using chimney sums (column addition).</p>	<p>Go shopping add up the cost of items. Work out the change you would get.</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect different food packages and order them from the lightest to the heaviest. • Looking at your food packages convert the different measurements, e.g., millilitres to litres or grams to kilograms. 	<p>Go onto Jit 5 on Hwb, use the pictogram graph program to produce a pictogram of your family's favourite fruit. Save it in your folder so we can look at it together in class.</p> 
Welsh Dimension	<p>Make some traditional Welsh food – bara brith, Welsh cakes, cawl or something else. Take some photos and upload to your Hwb folder.</p>	<p>Make a poster or packaging in Welsh to advertise the Welsh food you have made.</p>	<p>Dydd Gwyl Dewi Hapus! Celebrate St David's Day on Wednesday March 1st.</p> 	<p>Play some games in Welsh on this website: www.learnwelsh.net</p>
