<b>Language, Literacy and Communication</b> 	Can you record a video, telling us all about a model you have made? Maybe you could use Lego or construction toys? <b>Cymraeg</b> 	Can you listen to a Welsh song? Maybe see if you can learn the words.   <a href="#">Caru Canu   Pen Ysgwyddau (Welsh Children's Song)</a>	Can you find the Welsh names for these modes of transport?  
<b>Expressive Arts</b> 	Can you create an aeroplane model using recycling from your house?  	Can you learn a song and perform it to your family and friends?  
<b>Science and Technology</b> 	Can you make or find a toy boat? See if you can test how well it floats in water. Is your boat strong enough to hold something?  	Can you find your pulse? See if you can count how many beats you can count in 10 seconds.  
<b>Mathematics and Numeracy</b> 	Go on a walk and look at car number plates. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Add the digits together</li><li>• Find the largest/smallest number</li><li>• Count how many plates include an even number</li></ul>	<b>Ramp Challenge</b>  Make a ramp with books. Measure how far different vehicles travel. Record results using marks or numbers.
<b>Humanities</b> 	Do you find a picture of an old mode of transport? Maybe a relative or friend may have had a car that looks different to our cars now.  	Can you find our closest airport on Google Earth?  

<b>Health and Wellbeing</b> 	Do whatever makes you happy! This could be playing in the garden, doing some colouring or just spending time with family, as long as you're happy! 	Can you follow a recipe and bake something tasty?
