School Tidy Up Day

Following discussions with the Friends of Berriew group it is clear that school parents are concerned about the appearance of the school and general tidiness of the school grounds.

Since the beginning of the term, we have been trying to reorganise the inside of the school with new classes and getting rid of old furniture and resources. A second skip has been arranged to remove the rubbish from the school site.

However, we are aware that the field, trees, and building need some additional TLC. The local authority does not help with clearing gutters, window cleaning etc and so it falls on the school to do this.

We have been in discussions with the LA for a while now about redecorating the outside of school but to no avail. As a result, several parents have suggested that we pull together as a school community to do this work.

Consequently, we are looking out for volunteers with some skills to help clear the gutters, tidy up the trees and cut back nettles etc. If anyone can do anything with our willow tunnel that would be helpful and other people are just needed to help clear things away and sweep up around school. With support from Montgomeryshire Wildlife Trust and the Pre-school we hope to develop the outside field area this year following on from the outdoor classroom that was erected last year.
