<p><b>Maths &amp; Problem Solving</b> (Maths, thinking skills, Logic, Problem solving)</p> 	<p>Draw a fairy tale castle using shapes, name all the 2D shapes you have used (circle, square, rectangle, triangle, oval, star, hexagon, pentagon, octagon) then name the 3D shapes used (sphere, cylinder etc).</p>	<p>Draw a beanstalk, count and climb up the leaves.</p> <p>Can you count in steps of 2s, 5s and 10s?</p> <p>Can you count in steps of 3s, 4s?</p> 	<p>Can you make your own clock at home and learn how to tell the time?</p> <p>O'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to</p> 	<p>Go on a hunt around your home and find different containers with different measurements on them. Compare the measurements. You could collect things like the milk from the fridge- see how many litres are in a container? Record what you find.</p>
