<p><b>Language, Literacy and Communication</b></p> 	<p><u>Make a quiz:</u> Write a quiz about Romans. Ask your family to complete it, then bring it into school and see if your friends can complete it.</p> 	<p><u>Research</u> Find and copy 10 Roman words that are used today in our language.</p> 
<p><b>Cymraeg</b></p> 	<p><u>Disgrifio (describe)</u> Find a picture of what is important (pwysig) to you about Wales and describe why it is important to you with the title 'Pwysig I fi'.</p> 	<p><u>Darganfod (discover)</u> Find a song in Welsh you haven't learnt in school and practice your pronunciation.</p> 
<p><b>Expressive Arts</b></p> 	<p><u>Become a roman soldier</u> Can you make a roman sword using recyclable items?</p> 	<p><u>Listen and compare</u> Find and listen to some Roman music and in a table compare what you find different or similar to the music you listen to today.</p> 
<p><b>Science and Technology</b></p> 	<p><u>Become a presenter</u> Make a PPT of at least 6 slides about an animal of your choice. You must include, how the animal grows and the animal's habitat.</p> 	<p><u>Research</u> Research how Roman chariots move, list some things that have similar mechanics.</p> 
<p><b>Mathematics and Numeracy</b></p> 	<p><u>Make a clock</u> Using recyclable materials make a 2D clock with roman numerals.</p> 	<p><u>Practice times tables</u> Sign into TTRS and play on soundcheck at least 5 times. Record your first score and see if you can beat your score.</p> 
<p><b>Humanities</b></p> 	<p><u>Create a fact file</u> Research how the romans lived and create a fact file about their lifestyle.</p> 	<p><u>Find on a map</u> Find on a map a country the Romans conquered and when they conquered that country. Find 5 facts about the country that you find interesting.</p> 
<p><b>Health and Wellbeing</b></p> 	<p>Do whatever makes you happy! This could a sport, doing some art or just spending time with family, as long as you're happy! If you take pictures or have something to bring in you can share it with the class.</p> 	<p><u>Admiration and respect</u> Draw a picture of you with your family or fiends and label what you admire and respect about the people you've drawn.</p>
