Get exploring on the map! Can you study the continents of the world, countries, capitals and oceans as we will be covering these this term.




Interview your own hero! This could be a relative or family member at home! Say what makes them a hero?




**Maths & Problem Solving (Maths, thinking skills, Logic, Problem solving)**
