## Food and Farming

Please choose one piece of homework each week to complete. Make sure you choose homework from different sections of the grid and upload one piece of work to your child's HWB file. We will show in class each Monday.

<p><b>Language, Literacy and Communication</b></p> <p><b>English</b></p>	<p>Create a poster about farms. You could include animals or crops and try labelling what you have drawn, e.g. cow, pig, corn, etc.</p> 	<p>Read a story about a farm. Retell the story to an adult, sister or brother trying to use different voices for each character.</p> 	<p>Write a list of words that rhyme with farm related objects, such as pig, cow, sheep, gate, etc.</p> 	<p>Reception -Recap all of Phase 2 sounds and start to learn new phase 3 sounds. Start to learn how to read and write some of the phase 2 and 3 tricky words.</p> <p>You could access Phonic Play <a href="https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/">https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/</a></p>

You could use the free Magi Ann app to read stories.</p> 
<p><b>Expressive Arts</b></p>	<p>Make a collage of a farm animal - you could even go on a nature hunt to find the resources.</p> 	<p>Build a piece of farm machinery using junk.</p> 	<p>Learn a new song about food or farming or compose and sing a song or perform a dance about food or farming.</p> 	<p>Do some printing with cut-up pieces of fruit and vegetables.</p> 

<b>Science and Technology.</b>	<p>Try planting some seeds, look after them and make a diary of what happens.</p> 	<p>Using JIT5 on Hwb, make a picture of a farm yard.</p> 	<p>Make a fruit smoothie or fruit kebab as part of a healthy diet.</p> 	<p>Design a farm building using construction materials; upload a photo of it onto your Hwb (j2launch) folder.</p> 
<b>Mathematics and Numeracy</b>	<p>Continue to practise counting objects reliably and matching them to the correct number card to the amount of objects. Extension - if your child is confident at recognising and counting, try adding one more or one less.</p>	<p>Make animals using 2D or 3D shapes getting the children to name the shapes they are using.</p> 	<p>Play farms with your toys - count how many animals you have, and then take some to market, how many do you have now? Etc. Upload a video onto Hwb.</p>	<p>Continue to learn the days of the week and months of the year. Extension - if your child is secure at this, start to look at recognising o'clock.</p> 
<b>Humanities</b>	<p>Go for a walk at look at the local environment - are there any signs of farming? Take photos on your walk and upload them.</p> 	<p>Look at food packaging in your house and make a list of where they come from.</p>	<p>Get your child to plan their own farm yard. Ask them questions like what is left of the sheep pen? What is south of the farm housing? Etc.</p>	<p>Split a page into quarters and write each season name in each section then draw a picture of what happens in farms in that season or draw what flowers, fruit and vegetables grow.</p>

If you have any creative ideas of your own which you would like to do one week instead of doing one of the projects that's great. Any word processing other ICT based learning, needs to be uploaded onto your child's Hwb folder.

Please remember your Hwb folders are where you store your home based **digital learning** only. Your child can go on to <https://hwb.wales.gov.uk/> and log in on the top right. Once they have logged in click on j2e on the top right. You then need to select the JiT program. Once you are on JiT you can select different activities to do on the top right. Please give your child the opportunity to have a go on the different programs that Hwb has to offer.
